**ALASKA MIGRATORY BIRD CO-MANAGEMENT COUNCIL MEETING,
September 24-25, 2008**

The **Alaska Migratory Bird Co-management Council** will conduct its fall meeting on September 24-25, beginning at 9:00 a.m. The meeting will be held at the Bristol Bay Native Association Family Resource Center, Dillingham, Alaska.

The Co-Management Council, which includes Alaska Native, State and Federal representatives as equals, was formed March 28, 2000 by the U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service as required by the amended migratory bird treaties with Canada and Mexico.

The purpose of the meeting is to identify any conservation concerns that may be addressed for the 2010 season. The Council will also listen and act on committee reports such as the Harvest Survey Committee. Members of the public may comment on agenda items at the beginning and end of the sessions. Copies of the meeting agenda will be available at the meeting.
