The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service has negotiated (under the provisions of the Indian Self-Determination and Education Assistance Act, Public Law 93-638) a tentative annual funding agreement with the Council of Athabascan Tribal Governments at Fort Yukon, Alaska, to perform activities on the Yukon Flats National Wildlife Refuge in 2004 and 2005. The 45-day public comment period on this action will end March 29, 2004.
